23/085 PLANNING APPLICATIONS & ISSUES

23/085.1 **High Street, Arlesey Public Consultation-** Members considered response to online consultation commencing at 5pm on Monday 23rd October.

Resolved that council submit a consultation response objecting to the plans due to inappropriate and dangerous access/egress onto the High Street via Rose Cottages; Temporary access for construction vehicles should be made via Eastern section of relief road joining High Street with A507. Clerk to complete consultation responses to reflect this. Councillors encouraged to respond as individuals/residents.

23/085.2 **CB/23/02601/FULL: Field to the west of Mill Lane and north of Arlesey Industrial Estate, Mill Lane, Arlesey.**
Proposal: Erection of a barn to store: grain, machinery and hay/straw.

Resolved that council OBJECT to the application on the following grounds:

- Land on Arlesey Common

- Negative impact on biodiversity and eco-habitat of surroundings from removal of trees, flora and fauna.
- Potential impact on protected wildlife species
- Current land use does not convey requirement for grain/hay store.
